and found on this survey.

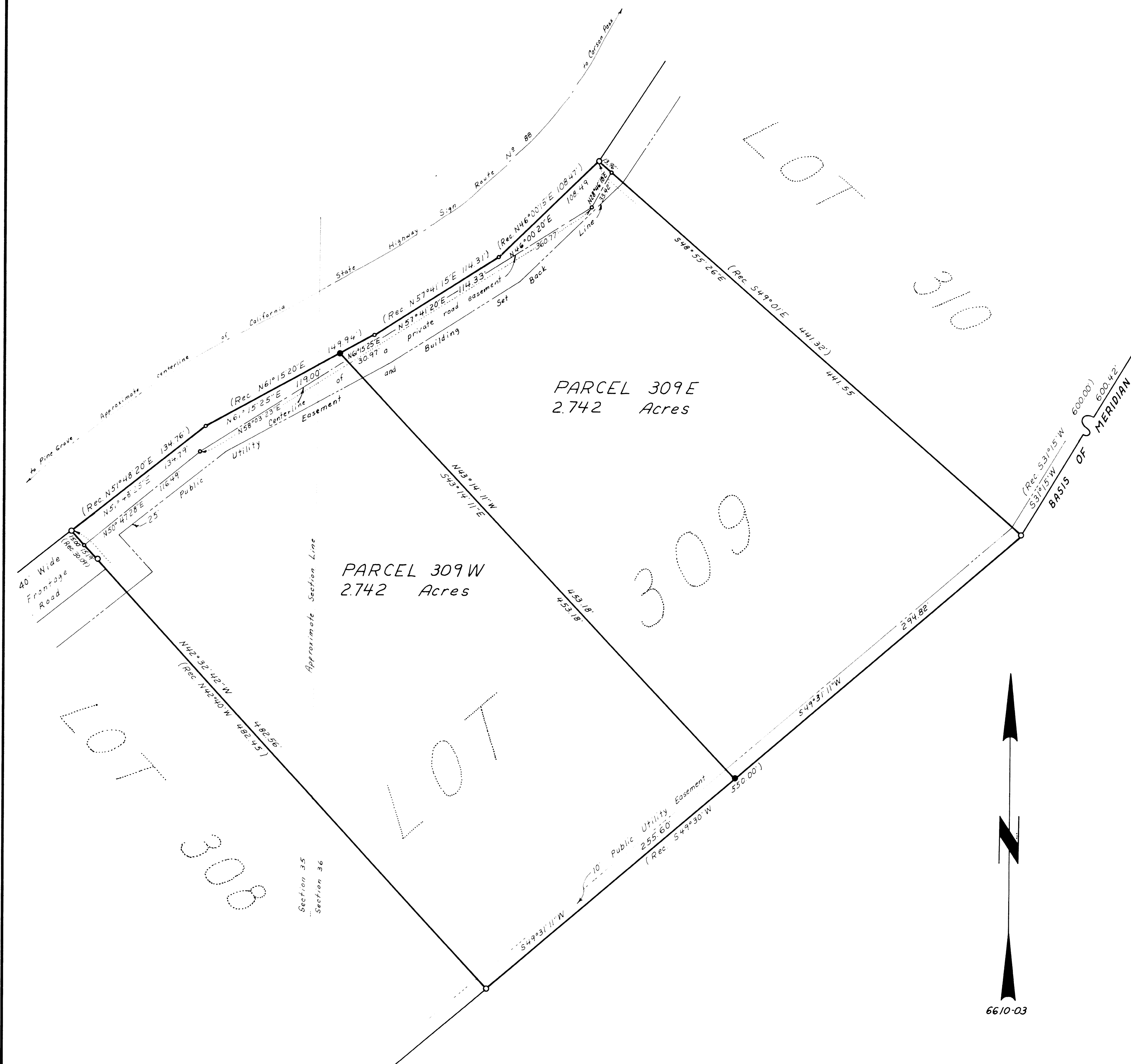
The meridian of this survey is referred to the Southeast
