Terrain In Subdivision Gentle slope towards Highway 395 with moderate to heavy tree growth. The elevation is approximately 6,000'.

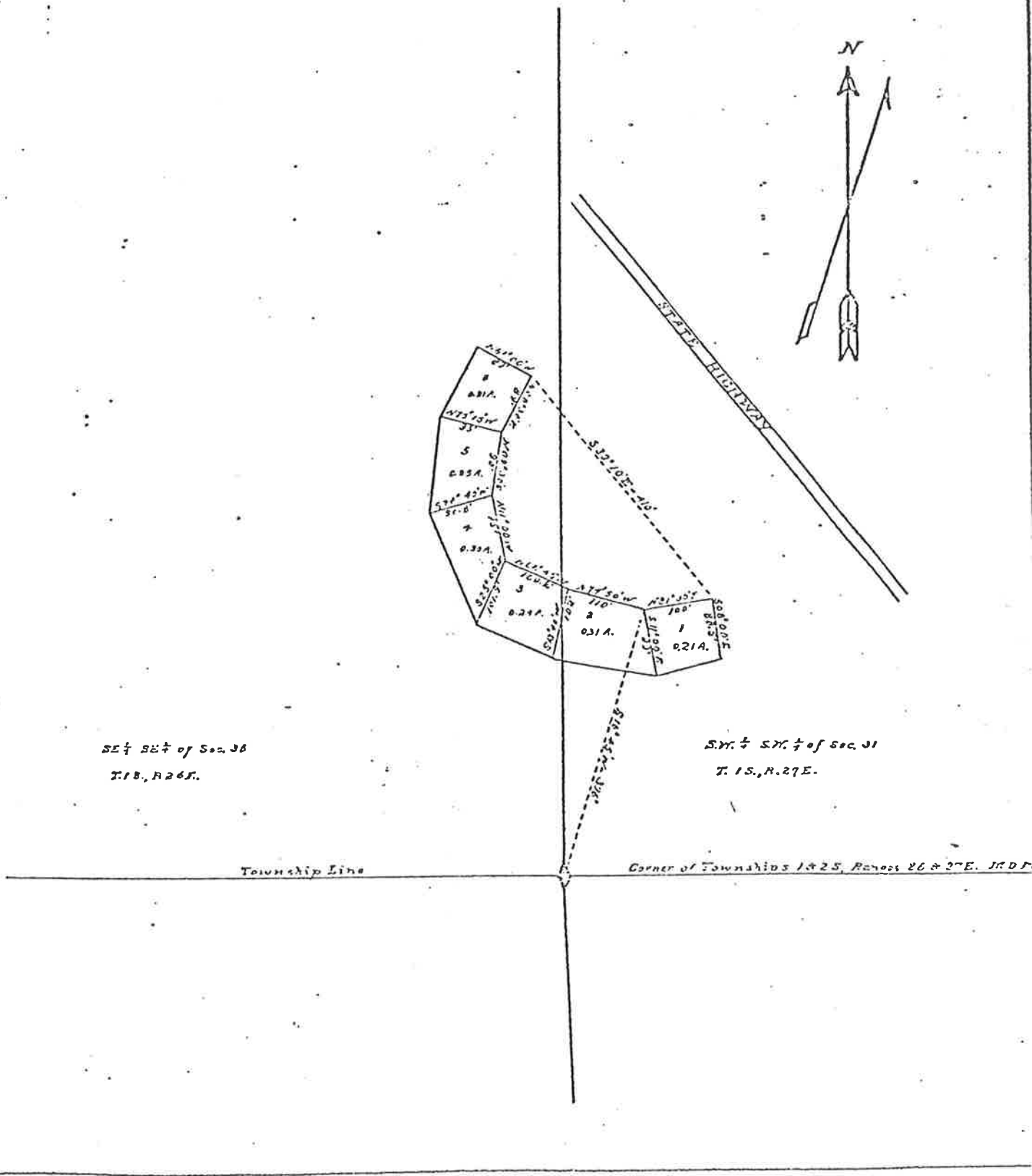
